Itinerary

Day 1 Cartagena

Depart from Canada and fly to Cartagena, Colombia. Transfer from the airport to your hotel in Cartagena. Look for a sign with your name on it.

Day 2 Cartagena

WALKING CITY TOUR IN CARTAGENA (3 hours)

Explore the walled city with your personal guide who will tell you about Cartagena's past and present when visiting monuments such as the Clock Tower or Don Pedro de Heredia's statue, the city's founder as well as other less visited parts of the historic center.

You will also cross by Parque Bolivar, facing the Palace of the Inquisition, which is one of the most beautiful buildings in the city and San Pedro Claver square, dedicated to the Spanish-born monk known as "Slave of the Slaves" for his life spent ministering African slaves brought to the Spanish colonies. Also the Getsemani district, named by Forbes Magazine as one of the coolest neighborhoods in the world, will not be missed on this city tour.

Optional 1 - Tour Gabriel Garcia Marquez (USD \$79/person)

Optional 2 - Coffee Roasting and Tasting in Getsemani (USD \$59/person)



Day 3 Rosario Island

You will have a private transfer from your hotel in Cartagena to the harbour - San Pedro de Majagua Hotel.

The boat departs from Cartagena at 8:30 am, so it is recommended that you arrive at 8:00 am to check in. The boat leaves from La Bodeguita Pier at 2:30 pm.

Shared Services

The Rosario Islands are located about 40km (about 1 hour by boat) southwest of Cartagena. They consist of 27 islands and 20 hectares of coral islands and

reefs. Some of them are not accessible as they are mainly mangroves and coconut trees. During this day trip you will have enough time to explore the beautiful nature and relax on the beach. There you will also be served a typical lunch.

Transfer from the harbour to your hotel in Cartagena.

Optional - MOUNTAIN BIKE TOUR ON THE ISLAND TIERRA BOMBA (USD \$149/person)

We will start our tour in the early morning at 7 am. A Van will bring us to the beach of Castillo Grande, where our professional Mountain Bikes are waiting for us, as well as the boat which will bring us to Tierrabomba Island.

After arriving on the island we will start our 3 to 4 hours bike tour across the undulating countryside, up – and downhill included!

The whole distance is about 68 km, but we will adjust, change or shorten the distance due to your physical ability.

There are varied easy and challenging paths. We can have breaks and photo stops as you like.

Optional - Salsa Tour Quiebracanto (USD \$89/person)

Day 5 Barranquilla

You will have a private transport from Cartagena to Santa Marta. At the halfway point, in Barranquilla, you will make a stop to do an activity.

STOPOVER IN BARRANQUILLA: CITY TOUR, COOKING CLASS & LUNCH.

You are welcome to discover the happy city of the Colombian Caribbean. The tour begins with a visit to the historic neighborhood of El Prado. After visiting the church of the Immaculate Conception and appreciating some of the beautiful Republican mansions, symbols of the economic boom caused by the steam navigation on the Magdalena River at the beginning of the 20th century, we visit the imposing Metropolitan Cathedral María Reina and the la Paz Square.

You will participate in a cooking class where you will learn about the process of preparing the local gastronomy as well as the products and techniques. After the activity you will have time to have lunch and tour Barranquilla.

Optional - Tour to the Mud Volcano Totumo (USD \$121/person)

Day 6 Tayrona National Park

Tayrona National Park is one of the most beautiful places in the country. You can find a variety of trails that pass through the rainforest and the tropical dry forest with amazing archaeological sites along their paths.

You will leave Santa Marta to take the scenic route along a coastal road to reach the eastern entrance of the park. From the Cañaveral sector you begin to walk through the dry forest until arriving at the Arrecifes sector. This is a perfect time for you to rest and refresh before continuing to the Arenilla Beach, Piscina Beach and to Cabo San Juan. You'll have plenty of time to enjoy the beach and in the afternoon you'll return to Cañaveral where your transportation will be waiting after hiking back for about two hours. You will then return to Santa Marta.

You will have a lunch a la carte.

*Note: it is recommended to begin the tour at 08h00. The Tayrona Park has a tropical and humid climate, so it is advisable to bring comfortable clothes, walking shoes, a hat and sunscreen. Also bring a swimsuit for the beach.

Day 7 Santa Marta

WALKING CITY TOUR SANTA MARTA

The City of Santa Marta, privileged for its location between the sea and the Sierra Nevada, is the oldest existing city in Colombia and the second oldest in South America.

We continue to the center of Santa Marta, where we visit the oldest Cathedral in the country, then stroll through the old, colonial center with its rich history - pirate attacks, the importance of the port during the banana boom, the Gold Museum Tayrona (closed on Mondays), San Francisco Church, Simón Bolívar Park, the Parque de los Novios.

Optional - MINCA, MARINKA VALLEY & COFFEE FARM LA VICTORIA (USD \$146/person)

Day 8 Santa Marta - Bogota

Fly to Bogotá, upon arrival, transfer to your hotel. The rest of the day is free to relax.

Day 9 Bogota

BOGOTÁ CITY TOUR - LA CANDELARIA HISTORIC DISTRICT (Full Day)

Today you will explore the Colombian capital of Bogotá during a walking tour. Bogotá has 2 different sectors for tourism. The first is the old Candelaria Historic District scattered with traditional colonial houses and cobblestoned streets. The second sector and by contrast, the north of the city boasts modernity and innovation. Tourists will find government buildings, as well as a variety of trendy shops, restaurants and bars.

Bogotá's historic city center "La Candelaria" with its impressive churches, the State Palace and the "Plaza Bolívar" will be explored with the company of your guide explaining each building's history in detail. Furthermore, you can visit the world famous gold museum "Museo del Oro", the Emerald Museum and the museum of the famous Colombian artist Botero.

* Please note that the Gold Museum is closed on Mondays, the Emerald Museum on Sundays and the Botero Museum on Tuesdays.

Visit **Gold Museum** and **Cerro de Monserrate** afterwards.

* Golde Museum is closed on Mondays.

Optional - WEAVING PEACE - SHORT VERSION (3 hours) (USD \$146/person)

Day 10 Bogota - Home

After breakfast, transfer to airport and board the flight back to your home.
