# Itinerary

## Day 1: Home - Lima

When you arrive in Lima, the City of Kings, our team will be on hand to cordially welcome you at the airport. They will drive you in our private van to your hotel.

## Day 2: Lima

The first stop on our Lima city tour is Huaca Pucllana, a huge archaeological site in Miraflores, one of Lima's most popular districts.

After exploring Huaca Pucllana with your guide, we'll drive to the historic center of Lima, all of which is a designated UNESCO World Heritage site. We'll go to the beautiful Plaza de Armas (Lima's main square) which is surrounded by impressive colonial and Republican-era buildings, many of which have ornate wooden balconies.

We'll visit the Cathedral of Lima. Inside, we'll see the sculptures and paintings that decorate the interior. The cathedral is also home to the tomb of the conquistador Francisco Pizarro.

Next we'll walk one block to the Convent of Santo Domingo. Founded in the 1530s and completed in 1766, it is one of the most important religious buildings in Peru, and its large bell tower is a landmark in the historic center of Lima.

This is the last stop on our Lima city tour, but if you want to know more about this fascinating and historic city, you can join us on one of our Lima city tour extensions.

## Day 3: Lima - Cusco

After breakfast, a representative will pick you up from the hotel (time to be confirmed) and take you to the airport where you will take your flight to Cusco. Once you arrive in Cusco, a representative will be waiting at the airport to pick you up in our private transport and take you to your hotel.

**Optional - Lunch at the Incanto Restaurant (USD\$25/person)**

In the afternoon, when we'll first head to the wonderful Koricancha, next door to Santo Domingo Church. Some people recognize it as the most sacred and most important temple in the Inca Empire.

After visiting the Koricancha, we'll head to Cusco Cathedral, located on the Plaza de Armas.

Our next stop is the imposing Inca fortress of Sacsayhuaman, which sits on a hill above Cusco. Here you will see some of the finest examples of Inca stonework and construction, including massive rocks that were carefully cut and perfectly fitted together to form the walls.

From here you'll also have beautiful panoramic views of Cusco.

After exploring Sacsayhuaman we'll head up the hill to the Tambomachay Archeological Complex.

Tambomachay is the last attraction on our city tour, after which we'll head back down into Cusco and drop you off at your hotel.

After breakfast, enjoy a free day to explore Cusco at your ease. The capital city of the Inca Empire is now the undisputed archaeological capital of the Americas, as well as the continent's oldest continuously inhabited city.

## Day 5: Cusco - Machu Picchu

Our tour begins in Cusco, where we'll pick you up at 09h00 and then head to the train station to board the train to Aguas Calientes (also known as Machu Picchu Pueblo). The train leaves at approximately 11h30. The two-hour train journey will take you through river canyons and rolling hills.

Aguas Calientes is the gateway to Machu Picchu, sitting in a deep gorge at the foot of the mountain upon which Machu Picchu is located. Aguas Calientes is surrounded by jungle-covered mountains and cliffs, and the Urubamba River flows right next to the town, sometimes roaring through the canyon.

Aguas Calientes is also surrounded by thermal hot springs, and when we arrive you'll have plenty of time to relax and enjoy a dip in one of the steaming natural springs. You'll also have time to walk around the town, exploring the colorful markets and general buzz of this unique Peruvian settlement.

## Day 6: Aguas Calientes - Cusco

Wake up early for breakfast before our guide will pick you up from your hotel at 5:40am to begin the short bus journey to the gates of Machu Picchu where you will watch the sunrise. After entering the Citadel begin a guided walking tour (approximately two hours) of the citadel complex. After this experience, enjoy some free time to explore the mysterious city as you please.

## Day 7: Cusco - Puno

After breakfast, you'll be picked up from your hotel at 06h30 and dropped off at the bus station to take a bus trip, more like a tour - a guide will be on board, and you'll stop at four exciting sites:

(1) Andahuaylillas: The Sistine Chapel of South America. This church is one of the most beautiful examples of Andean popular religious art.

(2) Raqchi (Wiracocha God Temple): This was an Inca church of considerable dimensions; 328 feet long, 85 feet wide and 45 feet high. The temple is divided into two naves, and each nave has 11 large columns.

(3) La Raya: This is the half-way point between Cusco and Puno and also the highest point (14,222 feet above sea level). The landscapes here are stunning and typical Andean animals like the llama, alpaca and vicuña are familiar sights. It is also the geographic border between two cultures - Quechua and Aymara.

(4) Pukara: This is the most important and oldest ceremonial center of the altiplano. There are new lite-sculptures and tombs.

Arrival time to Puno will be around 5 pm.

Check in to your hotel. The rest day is free.

## Day 8: Taquile island

After breakfast, you will go out boat riding on Lake Titicaca. Pick up time at your hotel will be around 07h00. You will go over to the port, board our motor launch, and ride south to the Island of Uros.

Afterwards we will sail towards "Taquile Island". At Taquile, you will enjoy a 2-and-a-half-hour tour of the island which has been ranked the fourth most beautiful island in the world. In the community you will eat a wonderful Andean style buffet lunch.

Here you will visit the isolated weavers of this ancient community. According to pre-Columbian legend, the Incas actually learned how to weave from the artisans of this island. They are very, very skilled weavers. Taquile has been declared to be part of the Cultural Heritage of the Humanity by UNESCO.

Later in the afternoon, you will then have free time to explore the Island on your own, and afterwards return to Puno.

## Day 9: Puno - Lima

After Breakfast, transfer Hotel to Juliaca Airport for your flight at home via Lima. On arrival at Lima airport a transfer will be arranged to the hotel where the rest of the evening is at leisure.

## Day 10: Lima - Home

This morning you will be picked up from the hotel and transferred to the airport.
